Dear Parents and Carers,

This week saw the start of term with the welcome announcement from government that schools can begin to welcome children back from the 8th of March. 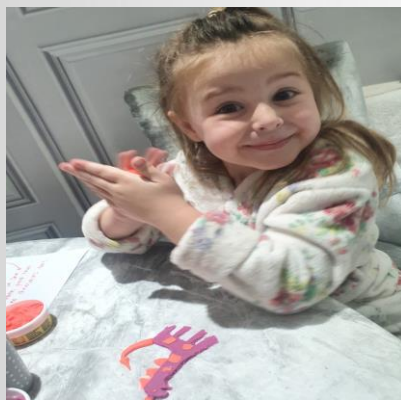
